CONTEST DESCRIPTION

Jasper Display Corp. (JDC) believes that building optics knowledge with state-of-the-art lab tools is the key to the next wave of innovation. To support this vision and contribute to the optical community, JDC is holding a contest to win one of two Education Development Kits (EDKs) at BFY III!

The JD955B EDK is a Liquid Crystal on Silicon (LCoS), SLM-based system that provides in-depth, hands-on optical training via a series of ten optical experiments. Optics students and engineering professionals will be able to learn optics fundamentals quickly and easily with the EDK. The EDK includes a complete lab manual that covers phase, wavefront, and amplitude modulation, dispersion, holography, diffraction, interference, and additional topics. LabVIEW software with a rich GUI is included to guide the experiments and control the SLM hardware.

The EDK is a compact, flexible training solution designed to easily integrate into modern optical labs and cover a wide variety of key experiments.

HOW TO ENTER

To enter for a chance to win one of two EDKs, valued at approximately \$5000 USD each, contestants must submit an explanation of what they would do if they had an EDK. Please cover any or all of the following points:

- your interest in and/or past experience with Spatial Light Modulators
- how you would use your EDK
- how would the EDK impact your teaching and research
- how you would share your EDK experience and results with the optics community

CONTEST RULES

Entries must be submitted to contest@jasperdisplay.com by 1 PM EDT on August 17th, 2018. Entries must be no longer than one page (letter, 12 pt). A JDC committee will vote and the winner will be notified by email on Aug. 24th, 2018. Prizes will be shipped to the US address provided by the winner.

Entrants must be legal residents of the fifty (50) states or the District of Columbia who are 18 years of age or older. JDC employees and members of their immediate families are not eligible to enter. Contest winners must sign a release of liability and publicity release form before receiving their prize.
